This will allow us to compete in other associations including Newcastle Netball Association. This will be a whole new adventure for every player within NBNA. This will provide another playing avenue for our intermediate and senior players to be able to keep playing netball, grow their skills and play in a more diverse environment.

Bec Keating our president has worked with Newcastle Netball Association for the past 12 months, and this year took a trial team to NNA. Both players from NBNA, and NNA committee' feedback has been positive. This is the start of something that could be achieved over many more age groups and divisions.

Ashlee Hall our new pathways officer will be working with all players, coaches and umpires interested to get it all going for the 2025 season with our new club within the Newcastle Netball Association.



The Idea behind this?

Over the years we have noticed our intermediate and senior players drop off, in turn the competition become smaller. The last few years we have been able to grow our Wednesday Night seniors competition, but we want to bring back Saturday Netball for our Intermediate and Senior Players.

Players within NBNA over the years have moved to other associations to play more netball especially with it being on a Saturday, in stronger competitions, develop their skills and also due to changes within their life. We are hoping to capture this and provide this pathway for our players to be able to keeping playing and enjoying netball.

Feedback: The feedback we have received over the years has been players are getting bored, competition isn't strong enough, players enjoy playing on a Saturday and frustration from players who are playing teams not at their level or skill.

What does this mean?

- Players will have the option to play Saturdays in Newcastle but also still play at Nelson Bay Netball on a Wednesday night or for intermediates Saturday morning
- Improve their skills and have a growth in their game
- Play a more competitive and diverse game, playing against players they have never played before, and not the same teams every few weeks
- Being able to play in a division that suits the players skill level
- Bringing back the 'fun 'of netball and growing our association for the future



2024 Results

This year we trialed a team in Newcastle Netball Association. The had a team on 12 players due to injury and pre commitments we took a larger team over. This was to see how much interest would generate, also if we could pull this together, and branch out to this competition. The team was placed in Division 6, we originally asked for Division 4. The girls wore the old NBNA rep dress, but we have rebranded for the 2025 season.

Results: Grand Final Winners - Division 6 - 2024

Unfortunately there were 4 wet weather games, which they weren't made up. The girls played 7games, 2 byes and were undefeated this season.

Feedback: The girls all expressed how much they enjoyed playing in a new competition, back playing on a Saturday afternoon, playing with a different group of people, playing different teams, and most of all having fun!

• Play BOTH - Our winter competition and within our new club in at Newcastle



Expression of Interest Form

Key Information

- This is open to ALL players, 15 years and older
- Coaches are needed, if we have no coaches we can't take teams. Support will be provided by Ash and everyone on the committee
- Umpires are needed as each team has to supply umpires most weeks, and why not earn some money
- Season start date is estimated to start 5th April 2025 and will run for 12 -14 rounds (excluding school holidays)
- Grading Day TBA, to make sure all players are in the correct division within Newcastles requirements
- Uniform try on day -TBA (hopefully same as trial day)
